Commissioning of Lay Eucharistic Visitor

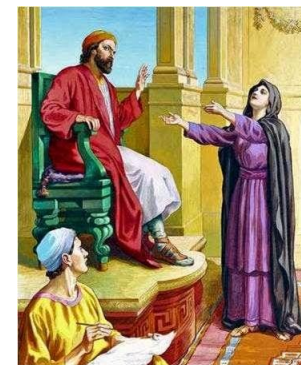
