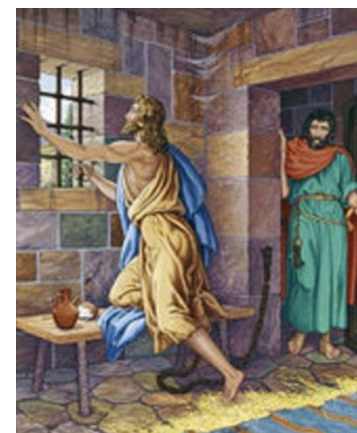
Babies and Children are welcomed at Mass. We do offer a nursery and Sunday school if you choose. One of the greeters will help you find the nursery and children's classrooms.

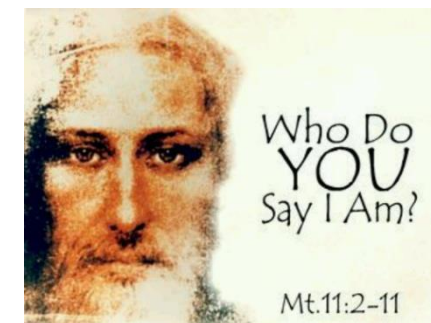
